Please consider giving a little of your time - your efforts will help Habitat for Humanity make a difference in the lives of many Dane County residents!

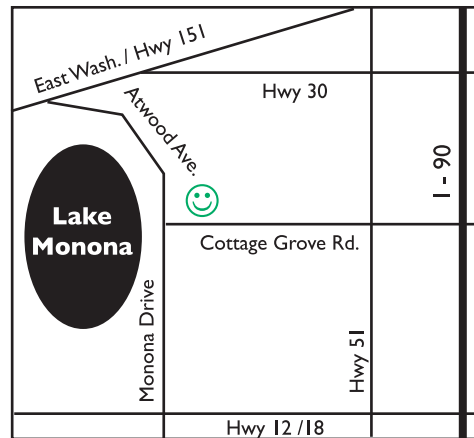
