The Habitat ReStore invites you to participate in an art show and auction that will benefit Habitat for Humanity of Dane County. The art pieces will be sold through an online auction, with the proceeds benefitting Habitat for Humanity. This year's show will be held at Shoo (formerly State Street Gallery), 109 State Street, Madison, WI, October 1 through October 29, 2010.

Pieces submitted for the show must be for sale and must have a salvage component. This may include found objects, recycled, or reused materials.

If you are selected you will receive a voucher for materials worth up to \$15 from the Habitat ReStore (208 Cottage Grove Road, Madison, WI) to use in your art piece. We encourage you to come in and let your imagination run wild!

The show will be juried by professional artists. Work will be evaluated on the skill, originality, design, composition, and salvaged components. There is no jury fee.



Working in partnership with Habitat for Humanity of Dane County, the Habitat ReStore retail operation provides a valuable source of cash flow through the sale of donated building materials. In an average year, the Habitat ReStore will allow Habitat to build two additional homes in Dane County. The Habitat ReStore keeps close to 1000 tons of building materials out of Dane County's landfills annually.
